Congratulations! We are delighted you will be attending this very special Commencement for our August & December 2025 Graduates and the Class of 2026. We look forward to celebrating with you and your family on **Friday, May 15th at 4 p.m.** on the main campus in Berlin, NH.

Please be advised to keep an eye on your student email as updates and further information will be provided. *Information below is subject to change.* Here is what you need to know:

- Commencement** This year's commencement ceremony will be held under a tent on the lawn of the main campus in Berlin, NH, at **4 p.m. on Friday, May 15th**, rain or shine. There will be a reception immediately following the ceremony.
- Announcements** Each student will receive two announcements. They are not required for admittance into the ceremony. There is no limit on total number of guests.
- Accommodations** If you or one of your guests will require special accommodations when attending commencement, such as special seating in the audience due to a wheelchair, or assistance getting from the parking lot to the tent, kindly notify Amanda Caron (acaron@ccsnh.edu) in the Registrar's Office as soon as possible.
- Streaming** The ceremony will be live streamed and recorded. This year's live stream link will be available on our web page, wmcc.edu, the day of the event.
- PTK Stoles** **If you are a member of the Honor Society be sure to bring your Honors Stole with you for the ceremony. If you need to borrow or rent an Honors Stole, please contact the Welcome Center at wmccwelcome@ccsnh.edu**
- Tassels** If you have earned **high honors** (GPA 3.75-4.0) or **honors** (GPA 3.3-3.74), you will receive your tassel at rehearsal. Honors designation is decided after Spring grades have been submitted. *Honors is decided by your overall GPA not just the Spring semester.* Please contact Amanda Caron WMCC Registrar at (acaron@ccsnh.edu), with any questions.
- Rehearsal** It is important that graduates attend rehearsal on **Friday, May 15th at 2pm.** Students should arrive by 1:45p.m. and will line up inside the building (by the library) by Academic Focus Area, and then alphabetically by program. Please look for wall notices as to where you should be lining up. There will also be WMCC staff members on hand to assist.
- Photography** A professional photographer will be taking pictures of each graduate after they have received their diploma before returning to their seat. Each graduate will receive two 5 x 7 and one 8 x 10 picture at no cost. Additional prints may be purchased by visiting www.normandphotography.com.
